You can be a part of this success by representing the Warriors in Season 2011, and we are looking for new talent to fill our junior teams. The junior lacrosse season runs in **Terms 2 and 3 on Saturday mornings**, and next year we will be entering teams in all junior grades (Boys and Girls **Under 11, Under 13, Under 15** and **Under 17**, plus mixed **Under 8** which is a non-competitive grade)

The Woodville Lacrosse Club is a family-orientated Club and provides an opportunity for the community to be involved in a welcoming, enjoyable and successful local club whose ethos is to – DEVELOP / ENJOY / SUCCEED. Junior teams are well supported by parents and great dedicated coaches whose aim is to improve the players skills and have lots of FUN!!!

All games are played on Saturday mornings during Terms 2 and 3. Under 8s and Under 11s run from 8.30–9.30, played on a home and away basis from club grounds. Boys' Under 13s and Under 15s run from 9.00–10.15, and Boys' Under 17s from 10.40–12.00, and are also played on a home and away basis. Girls' Under 13s, Under 15s and Under 17s are played in the West Parklands, with matches from 9.40–10.30, 10.40–11.30 and 11.40–12.30 respectively.

We train twice a week on Tuesday & Thursday evenings (5.00pm – 6.00pm) at the Woodville Lacrosse Club grounds, which are located at Drummond Avenue, Findon. Our playing fees are very low (from \$60 - \$120) and playing equipment is available for loan at a nominal cost (\$10 per item)

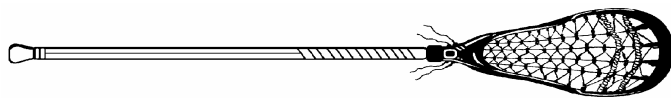
